Latest Market Updates from the New Hospital Programme

Recently an announcement was made that the government plans to fully integrate NHS England into the Department of Health and Social Care. We do not have anything further to add in relation to this news. While this has been happening, we remain focused on working to deliver the programme. We have achieved some major milestones in recent months for the NHP.

In order to keep you updated following the government announcement in January on the [New Hospital Programme: Plan for Implementation](#) and launch of the formal procurement process for the Hospital 2.0 Alliance framework in February, we have prepared a recorded **Market Briefing** (see link below).

We are also pleased to announce that we have officially awarded the Programme Delivery Partner contract to a joint venture, the Health Delivery Partnership (HDP) consisting of Mace and Turner & Townsend. The HDP will provide a wide range of technical and non-technical expertise and experience to the programme, allowing us to deliver the high-quality infrastructure that our health service needs, so this is a really important step.

Programme Update

Following the Secretary of State's announcement on the funding and plan for the New Hospital Programme in January this year, we remain focused on working to deliver the programme. This month we reached a major milestone with the announcement of our Programme Delivery Partner and look forward to completing the procurement for the Hospital 2.0 Alliance, which is currently midway through its Selection Questionnaire (SQ) process. We intend to award places on the framework later this year.

Update on plans for a Digital Partner

In addition, Digital remains central to the effective delivery of the Programme and will be a critical enabler of the transformation of care and hospital operations needed to address the challenges of the NHS in the future. We have previously engaged the market on our proposed approach to procuring a Digital Partner to support this. However following additional review and consideration, we've determined that the procurement of a single Digital Partner will not be pursued in the form previously communicated in our market engagement exercises.

We will continue to engage with Digital Suppliers in the coming months as a revised approach to the contracting of programme and scheme digital support becomes clear.
